

Hard Water Town and County list

WELzyme dilution rates...

WELzyme is a concentrated enzymatic cleaning solution supplied in sachets, a 1 litre dose bottle or a 5 litre container with a pelican pump.

A standard sachet of WELzyme should be diluted with 2 litres of water in soft to medium water areas. If your town or county is listed below it is advised to use a sachet of WELzyme Plus+ with 2 litres of water. A WELzyme plus sachet contains 4 times the amount of solution compared with a standard sachet.

If you are using WELzyme from a 1 litre or 5 litre container, the standard dilution in a soft to medium water hardness area is 5ml per litre of water. If your town or county is listed below it is advised to use 20ml per litre of water.

Bristol, Guildford, Oxford, Reading, Walton-on-Thames	Hard water

UK counties with the hardest water:

County	Water Hardness Level
Bedfordshire, Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Cambridgeshire, Dorset, Essex, Gloucestershire, Hampshire, Herefordshire, Kent, Oxfordshire, Surrey, Sussex, Wiltshire	Hard to very hard water
Greater London	Moderately hard water
